



## Hearts a Flutter Perpetual Wall Calendar

### Supplies:

Stamps: Hearts a Flutter,  
Memorable Moments

Inks: Whisper White, Calypso Coral, Baja Breeze, Lucky Limeade, Island Indigo, Pink Pirouette, and Jet Black Staz On

Cardstock: Calypso Coral, Baja Breeze, Lucky Limeade, Island Indigo, Pink Pirouette, and Basic Black

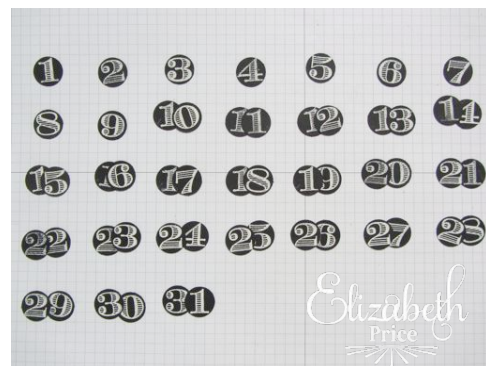
Accessories: Tea for Two DSP, Whisper White Embossing Powder, Hearts a Flutter Framelits, Labels Collection Framelits, Typeset Alphabet Bigz Dies, Basic Pearls, Calypso Coral Bakers Twine, 3/4" Circle Punch, 7/8" Scallop Circle Punch, Stampin' Dimensionals, Bright Buttons, Faceted Buttons, Bright Glimmer Brads, Medium Envelopes, Sticky Strip, Itty Bitty Framelits, Hung Up Cute Clips



Non SU!: 18" x 24" Frame, 18" x 24" Piece of Sheet Metal, Magnets, Embroidery Needle, Hot Glue

**Directions:**

Using Whisper White ink and the Memorable Moments stamp set stamp the numbers 1 - 31 on Basic Black card stock. Emboss each with Whisper White Embossing Powder and then punch out using the 3/4" Circle Punch.



From Calypso Coral, Lucky Limeade, Island Indigo, Pink Pirouette, and Baja Breeze card stocks punch out (53) 7/8" Scallop Circle pieces.



Using the Hearts a Flutter stamp set stamp a variety of images using Calypso Coral, Lucky Limeade, Island Indigo, Pink Pirouette, and Baja Breeze inks on Very Vanilla card stock. Cut out each image using the coordinating Hearts a Flutter Framelits. You'll need at least (16) pieces.



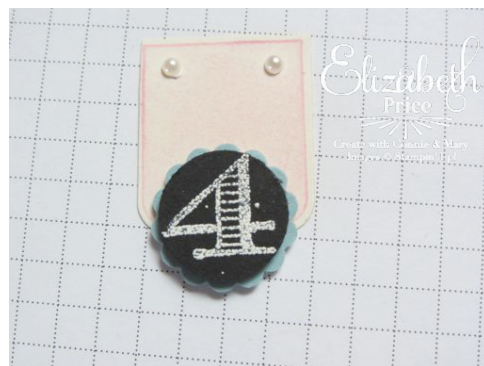
Cut a variety of Hearts of Flutter Framelit shapes from the Tea for Two DSP. You'll need at least (15) pieces.



Add a Stampin' Dimensional to the back of each embossed punched out number and to one side of the 7/8" Scallop Circle pieces.



Assemble numbers onto scallop circles and then onto the Hearts a Flutter pieces. Add Basic Pearls to the top corners of each number/pennant/date markers.



Using Whisper White ink and the Memorable Moments stamp set stamp the frame image on Basic Black card stock. Cut the frame using the Labels Collection Framelits. You will need a total of (35) pieces.



Cut (5) 30" pieces of Calypso Coral Bakers Twine. Using a large embroidery needle run one piece of the twine through the front of the top left and then through the back of the top right cut frames.



Repeat the above step to string (7) of the black cut label frames in a garland. Repeat the above to complete all (5) garlands.



Using a variety of Calypso Coral, Lucky Limeade, Island Indigo, Pink Pirouette, and Baja Breeze card stocks cut enough letters using the Typeset Alphabet Bigz Dies to spell the months of the year. Back each letter with another cut letter from Basic Black.



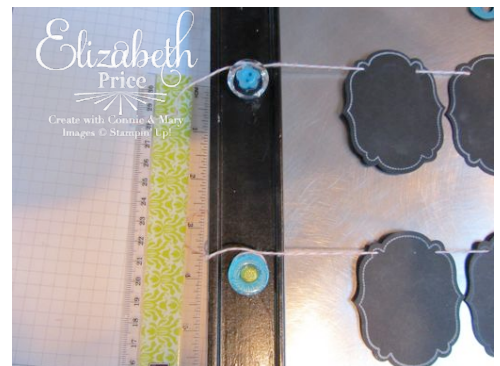
Adhere pieces together to create a shadow effect. Cut tiny pieces of self-adhesive magnets and adhere to the back of each letter. (I picked up inexpensive magnet strips at a hardware store).



Select a total of (10) Faceted Buttons and Bright Buttons then layer them with Bright Glimmer Brads or Bright Buttons. Adhere buttons to larger buttons with hot glue. Open the brad arms and push them through the buttonholes to attach to larger button.



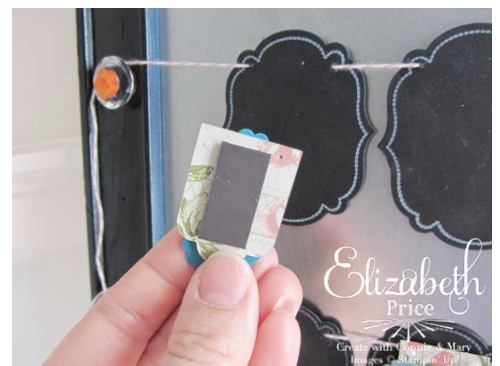
Using hot glue adhere (5) of the layered buttons to each of the long sides of an 18" x 24" frame. Glue the first button 6 3/4" from the top and then space each of the next (4) buttons 3 3/4" apart. Add an 18" x 24" piece of sheet metal to the frame. Wind each end of the Bakers Twine around the buttons to attach the garlands to the frame.



The garlands will suspend in front of the sheet metal and will not need to be adhered.



Add self-adhesive magnets to the back of each layered number/pennant dates. Arrange on garlands to match the current month.



Using Jet Black Staz On stamp the birthday and anniversary images on card stock. Cut out images using the largest Itty Bitty Framelits shape. Add to calendar using the Hung Up Cute Clips.

Adhere an envelope to the back of the frame to store extra numbers and the months with a piece of Sticky Strip.

Now you're ready for this month and when it comes time to reposition the calendar elements for next month you'll get a kick out of how easy it is to move it all around.
